

## Troop 273 Personal Equipment List

This list serves as a guide to equipment packing based on "typical" camping events. Here are some general ideas:

- This list is not inclusive. Scouts may find they need more items to pack than the contents of this list in order to be prepared!
- This list is not exclusive either. Every event does not require every item. Pack wisely and tailor your own list to your personal needs.
- Many of these items can be part of your existing home collection, borrowed, or home-fashioned. Do not run out and buy equipment in haste. Consult with the Quartermaster and Equipment Coordinator before making any purchases.
- Take into account the time of year, weather forecast, trip activities, and adjust as required. Be prepared!
- Equipment should be clearly and permanently marked with the owner's name.
- Don't worry! Though you may be packing for the first time the leaders in charge of an event will never let your health or safety be jeopardized by being unprepared.

### Clothing

- Biodegradable soap
- Hand sanitizer
- Deodorant
- Toilet paper (1/2 roll in plastic bag)
- Contact solution

- Cough drops/throat lozenges
- Comb/hairbrush

- Mess kit (utensils, plate, bowl, cup)
- Adequate food(s)
- Healthy, sustainable snacks

### Personal Gear
