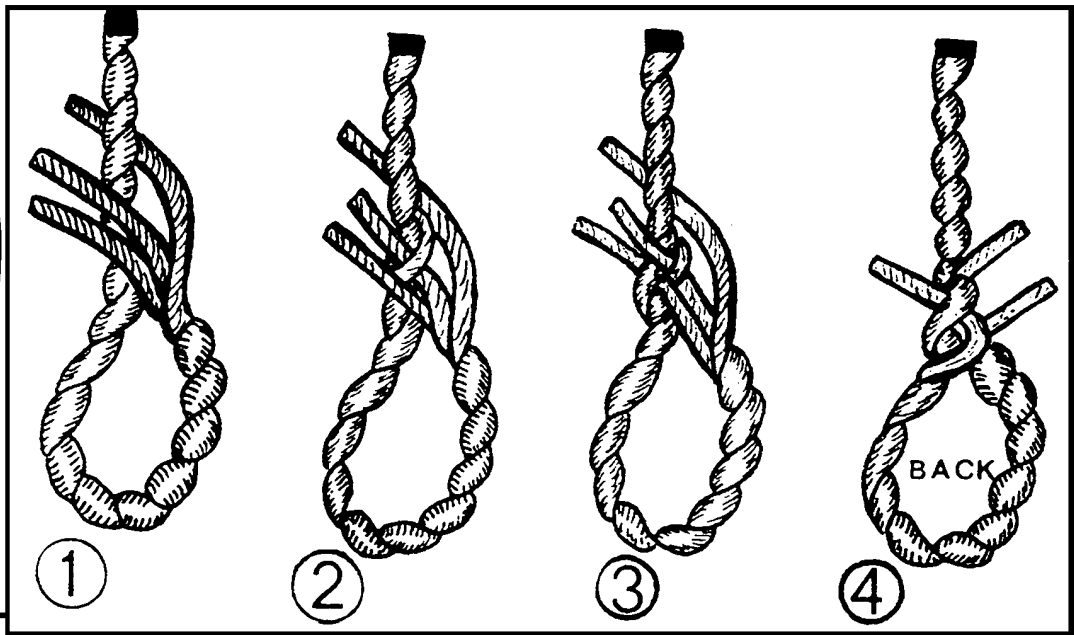

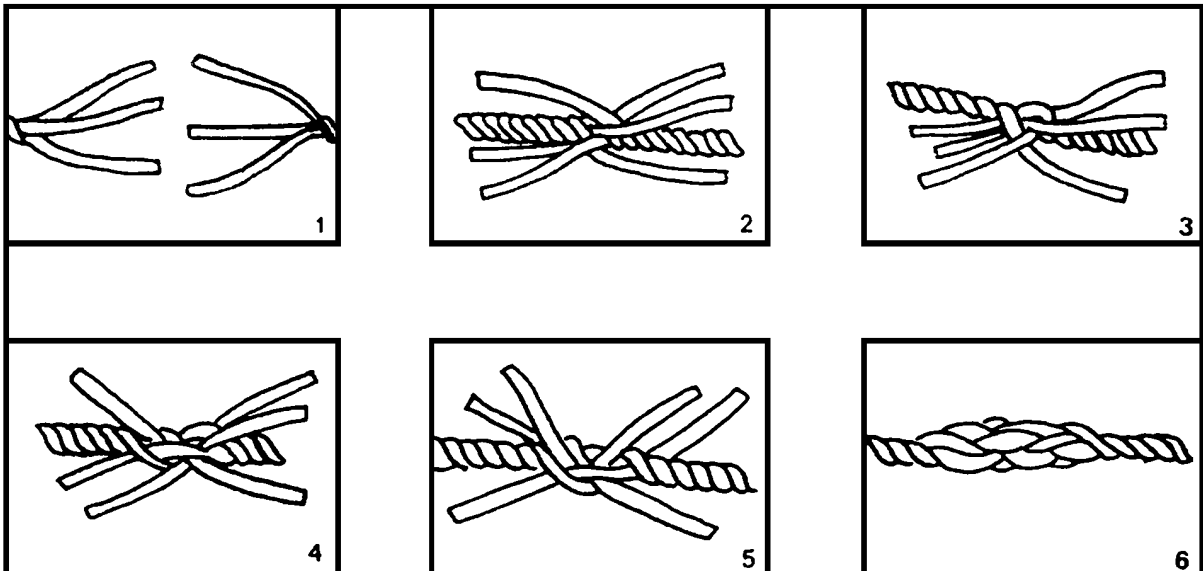
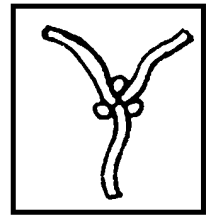
## SPLICING.2

### EYE SPLICE

To make the Eye Splice, the rope is formed into a loop and the strands are woven in as shown. Note the 4th drawing shows the back of the splice. After laying the rope in this manner, the strands are interwoven as in the Back Splice - see Chart No. 42. (With all splices there should always be one strand between each laid strand as shown in the diagram here)



### SHORT SPLICE

To make a Short Splice, the ropes to be joined are unravelled for a distance and placed end to end with the strands alternating. This is called marrying. Then the strands are woven into the laid rope in the usual "over and under" manner. Don't forget to taper the ends before finishing to get a neat effect.
