## MORE LASHINGS

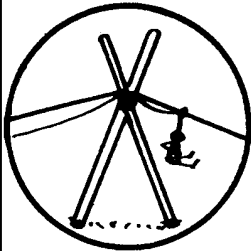


### DIAGONAL.

START WITH A TIMBER HITCH AROUND BOTH SPARS TAKE ROPE ACROSS AND MAKE TURNS AS SHOWN. THEN MAKE FRAPPING TURNS AND FINISH WITH A CLOVE HITCH.—NOTE! PULL ALL TURNS TIGHT.

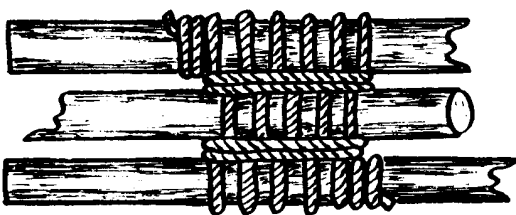
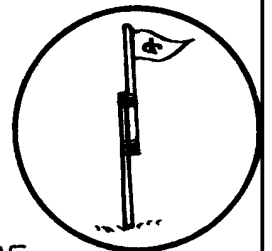
### SHEER — MARK 1 & 2.

**MARK 1.** START WITH A CLOVE HITCH AROUND ONE SPAR. FOLLOW UP WITH ABOUT 10 TURNS TAKE A FEW FRAPPING TURNS. DONT PULL TIGHT AS THIS

LASHING IS USED FOR SHEER LEGS~SEE INSERT.~END WITH A CLOVE HITCH.

**MARK 2.** START WITH A CLOVE HITCH AROUND BOTH SPARS FOLLOW WITH TURNS FINISH WITH A CLOVE HITCH. WEDGES MAY BE USED TO TIGHTEN THIS

LASHING— USED FOR JOINING SPARS AS IN FLAG POLE BUILDING.



### FIGURE OF EIGHT.

LAY SPARS~WITH TWO RUNNING ONE WAY AND THE THIRD IN THE OTHER~START WITH A CLOVE HITCH ON ONE OUTER SPAR THEN TAKE TURNS OVER AND UNDER. MAKE FRAPPINGS BETWEEN SPARS.~END WITH A CLOVE HITCH ON OPPOSITE SPAR TO START. USED TO MAKE TRIPODS.
